## COURAGE

**Someone brave enough to stand up for others when they are being disrespected.**

Bullying situations involve bullies, targets and bystanders. Everyone is negatively impacted by bullying. We can learn and practice strategies to put an end to bullying.

Teaching and modeling courage helps children stand up for what they know is right, even if others are not. It helps them to recognize when something is wrong and be willing to act to make it right.
